Jericho Plan Qualifications and Instructions

School Year Fall 2012-2013

To qualify for the Jericho Plan, students must meet all the following qualifications:

- 1. Have a minimum ACT score of 19.**
- 2. Submit a Jericho Plan letter of intent form.**
- 3. Submit a standard application for enrollment by April 14, 2012.**
 - A. You must submit a standard admissions application to Hyles-Anderson College by April 14, 2012.
 - B. Applications that are mailed must have a postmark no later than April 14, 2012.
 - C. Online applications must be received by 4:00 p.m. on April 14, 2012.
 - D. Applications may not be hand delivered.
 - E. No applications will be considered for the Jericho Plan if they are not submitted by the above date and time. The application will, however, be applicable to normal enrollment if received after the Jericho Plan due date.
- 4. Last date to complete application file: May 15, 2012**
 - A. The last date to complete application files is May 15, 2012. Application files that are not completed by this date will no longer be considered for the Jericho Plan for the fall 2012 school year.
 - B. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all references have been submitted and the application process is complete no later than the due date. All references must be submitted by U.S. mail or another parcel service that electronically records the delivery time and date. If you are not sure that your file is complete, please call us at 219-365-4031, Extension 1239. When you hand out reference forms, please remind those giving the reference of the time-sensitive nature of the reference. Do not assume we have received your references because you gave them to an individual.
 - C. The application file for the Jericho Plan will not be considered complete until all forms have been received.

5. Jericho Plan Acceptance

The decision of the Jericho Selection Committee will be based upon the stated criteria, and all decisions are final. No explanation will be given to applicants that are not accepted. Applicants will be notified by mail of their acceptance into the program.

6. Applicant must give evidence of his personal financial responsibility and his ability to use, manage, and control finances. (See Financial Assessment Form)

- A. Applicant must show the present state of his indebtedness.
- B. Applicant must disclose all financial assistance that he expects to receive in college.
- C. Applicants must disclose savings and/or investments that they own.
- D. Applicants must show evidence of a positive work record.
- E. If the applicant has not held a job, then the applicant must show through other testimonial evidence of work-related skills, work habits, and character.

7. Applicants must submit three handwritten essays that demonstrate maturity, wisdom, and clarity of thought and organization. (See Essay Forms)

- A. Each essay must be one to four hundred words.
- B. Essay Titles
 - 1) My Salvation Experience
 - 2) My Educational Goals for College
 - 3) My Personal and Ministry Goals After College
- C. **Essays will be examined for grammar and content.**

8. Applicants must submit four references. (See Reference Forms)

- A. A high school teacher (or an educator in the community if home schooled)
- B. Applicant's pastor
- C. Employer (or a work supervisor if student held an unpaid position)
- D. A ministry leader for which the applicant has worked in the local New Testament church

9. Application Fee - \$50

10. Upon acceptance, a \$500 nonrefundable commitment fee is due no later than July 1, 2012.

11. The cost of the fall 2012 Jericho Plan is \$1650.

12. American College Test (ACT Test)

- A. **All students applying to Hyles-Anderson College must take the American College Test.** The minimum composite score for application to the Jericho plan is 19.
- B. The ACT is a test given to high school juniors and seniors who plan to attend college. It is designed to test the student's knowledge base.
- C. Scores on the ACT test range from 1-36, with 36 being the highest. The national average ACT composite score is 21.
- D. There are four sections of the ACT exam: math, English, reading, and science.
- E. Students seeking admittance to Hyles-Anderson College must take the ACT on one of the test dates listed below.
- F. There are very rare exceptions when a student may be admitted to college without an ACT (e.g.: a student that has been discharged from the armed forces after the last testing date). Students must apply for exemption before coming to school. If a student is granted an exemption, he must take the ACT the first week of school.
- G. ACT Test Dates

- H. Log on to <http://www.actstudent.org/> for test locations in your area and to register online. When registering, **you will need to enter the Hyles-Anderson College School Code 1199 to have your test scores sent directly to the college.**
- I. By logging on to <http://www.actstudent.org/>, students may purchase practice tests. You are encouraged to take a practice test or do the daily practice test questions that are offered on this Website. Read the tab “Test Prep” very carefully so that you are well prepared for the test.
- J. Hyles-Anderson College uses test scores for determination of admission, academic counseling, and placement in English, spelling, and mathematics classes. Test scores are therefore very important.
- K. All forms for the Jericho Plan are downloadable as a PDF file on the Hyles-Anderson College Website, www.hylesanderson.edu

Please be aware that you must complete the normal admissions application process in addition to the Jericho Plan. That means you must submit a regular admissions application along with all associate forms (transcripts, references etc.). If you are not accepted into the Jericho Plan your regular application will be eligible for traditional enrollment.
