OFF-CAMPUS EMPLOYMENT

Veterans' Benefits

HAC is approved for veterans and other eligible persons under the provision of section 1776, Title 38, United States Code. (50–100% of tuition based upon credit hours and eligibility.)

HOW CAN I SAVE MORE ON MY TUITION?



Pastor's Child Scholarship

50% of normal tuition costs (for up to 18 credits) for all four years awarded to you if your father is a senior pastor or an associated Spanish ministry pastor.

Christian Worker's Child Scholarship

\$1,000 scholarship awarded to you if your head-of-household parent is employed in full-time Christian service (stateside or on the mission field).

Church-Matching Scholarship

If you are a new or transfer student and your church donates up to \$500 to your school bill, you can apply for a matching scholarship.

Married Student Scholarship

50% of normal tuition costs (for up to 18 credits) awarded to you if you are married prior to enrollment.

Church Multi-New-Student Scholarship

This one-time, \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to three or more new/transfer students from the same church who register/transfer the same semester.

ACT-For-Excellence Scholarship

This one-time scholarship ranging from \$500–\$1,500 (depending on your ACT score) will be applied to your first year of college.

Valedictorian/Salutatorian Scholarship

\$1,000 scholarship awarded if you are the valedictorian or salutatorian of your graduating class of five or more. (You must have a minimum ACT score of 21.)
