#### **Veterans' Benefits**

HAC is approved for veterans and other eligible persons under the provision of section 1776, Title 38, United States Code. (50–100% of tuition based upon credit hours and eligibility.)

# HOW CAN I SAVE MORE ON MY TUITION?

#### **Pastor's Child Scholarship**

50% of normal tuition costs (for up to 18 credits) for all four years awarded to you if your father is a senior pastor or an associated Spanish ministry pastor (stateside or on the mission field).

#### **Married Student Scholarship**

50% of normal tuition costs (for up to 18 credits) for all four years awarded to you if you are married prior to enrollment.

### **Christian Worker's Child Scholarship**

\$1,000 scholarship awarded to you if your head-of-household parent is employed in full-time Christian service (stateside or on the mission field). This will be applied to your first year of college.

#### Valedictorian/Salutatorian Scholarship

\$1,000 scholarship awarded to you if you are the valedictorian or salutatorian of your graduating class of five or more. This will be applied to your first year of college. (You must have a minimum ACT score of 21.)

#### **Church-Matching Scholarship**

If your church donates up to \$500 to your school bill, you can apply for a matching scholarship. This match is a one-time offer which may be used at any point during your college tenure.

#### **ACT-For-Excellence Scholarship**

This one-time scholarship ranging from \$500–\$1,500 (depending on your ACT score) will be applied to your first year of college.

## Church Multi-New-Student Scholarship

This one-time, \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to three or more new/transfer students from the same church who register/transfer the same semester. This will be applied to your first year of college.
