

Hyles-Anderson College Invitational Tournament

2023 Information Sheet

Residence Hall Housing

- Housing will be provided in Hyles-Anderson College residence halls at a rate of \$15.00 per person per night. (Subject to availability.)
- Anyone staying in the residence halls will need to provide their own bed linens and towels.
- Any team staying in the residence halls must have at least one chaperone per team.

ID Badges

- Upon arrival at your first game, each player and coach listed on your submitted roster will receive a team ID badge. This badge will allow the participants to eat in the dining hall at no cost as well as receive free access to all games. You will also receive five guest ID badges for sponsors, stat keepers, and a bus driver. These badges will grant them access to all games and meals as well.
- Any student that is not in one of the above categories, but is paying to stay in the residence halls, will receive a guest ID badge that will allow them access to meals in the dining hall at no cost, but will not grant them free access to games. The cost for game access is \$5.00 per day.
- The cost for any guest that is not paying to stay in the residence halls and does not qualify for an ID badge is \$5.00 per meal in the dining hall.

Midweek Service/Chapel

- The Wednesday midweek service will be held at 7:00 p.m. in the Evans Auditorium at Hyles-Anderson College.
- Tournament chapel: All teams must be in attendance for the 11:00 a.m. service on Thursday, November 30 in the Evans Auditorium at Hyles-Anderson College.

Meals

- Meal times in the DeCoster Dining Hall on Wednesday through Friday are as follows:
 - o Lunch – Wednesday, November 29 (11:30 a.m. - 2:30 p.m.)
 - o Dinner – Wednesday, November 29 (5:30-6:30 p.m.)
 - o Lunch – Thursday, November 30 (12:30-1:45 p.m.)
 - o Lunch – Friday, December 1 (12:30-1:45 p.m.)
- Meals will not be provided on Tuesday before the tournament or Saturday following the tournament.
- Sack lunches will not be available this year; however, the lunch hours on Wednesday, November 29 will be extended to accommodate team schedules.

Dress Code

- We ask all players, coaches, and personnel representing each team to abide by the dress code stated below.
 - o Wednesday evening service:
 - Men should wear a collared shirt and casual dress pants.
 - Ladies should wear a modest, knee-length skirt and appropriate top.
 - o All volleyball players must wear modest, knee-length culottes. Dress check will take place between 8:00-10:30 a.m. at the location of your first game. All volleyball teams must have their dress approved prior to their first game.
